## 1.32 Introducing penguins

**Topic:** Animals **Subtopic:** Birds

Activity type/skill: Text prediction

**Literacy focus:** Listening **Genre:** Information reports

## **Objective**

Ascertain and give credit for prior knowledge.

Predict what might be in a text about penguins.

• Use vocabulary essential for the topic.

## What you need

Student worksheet (see next page)

#### What to do

- 1. Look at the pictures on the student worksheet and talk about penguins to draw out students' existing knowledge of the subject and vocabulary.
- 2. Have students try to predict what might be included in a talk about penguins. Support them as they put their knowledge into words.
- 3. Work together to produce a simple star diagram of what might be covered in the talk and the knowledge they already have of the subject, for example:
  - what they are birds
  - where they live sea, ice, water
  - what they eat fish
  - what they look like no wings, black, stand up
  - what they do swim, walk, eat, lay eggs.
