


Using the Plants poster


What to do

1. Show the Plants poster and introduce the topic. Refer back to the poster as you work through the topic. Add more information to the poster as students learn more words.
2. Find out what students already know about plants – their parts and how they function.
3. Use known vocabulary to talk about plants.
4. Photocopy the poster to:
 - cut up to make a jigsaw for students to put together collaboratively
 - use for a labelling activity – make a word list students can use
 - use the labelled pictures for sorting activities.


Parts of a plant




Types of leaves




Life cycle of a flowering plant




Parts of a pine tree
