**Nouns:**

- Common nouns e.g. aluminium cans, jelly crystals
- Technical vocabulary e.g. ingots
- General vocabulary e.g. melt

**Prepositions:**

- Of place to, in, on etc., e.g. to a factory
- Of accompaniment with etc., e.g. with a tie wrap

**Articles:**

- Definite the, e.g. the plastic bag
- Indefinite an, a, e.g. a plastic bag

**Pronouns:**

- Object him, her, us, them etc., e.g. Turn them into ingots.

**Conjunctions and connectives:**

- Additive and, also, as well etc., e.g. Melt them and turn them into ingots.

**Adjectives:**

- e.g. cold, small, plastic

**Quantifiers:**

- a little, very, some etc., e.g. a little boiling water

**Question formation:**

- 'wh' e.g. What do you do first? When do you add the water?
- Subject reversal e.g. Is the water boiling?
- 'do' support
- when no auxiliary e.g. Does the gelatine dissolve?
- Modal 'can' e.g. Can you make a model cell?

**Short answer forms:**

- e.g. Yes, it does. No, it doesn't. Yes, it has. No, it hasn't. Yes, it is. No, it isn't.

**Verbs:**

- Imperative verbs e.g. collect, take, grind, melt
- Infinitive verbs e.g. How to recycle aluminium cans.

**Punctuation:**

- e.g. apostrophes, question marks, upper/lower case, full stops, commas, numerals
