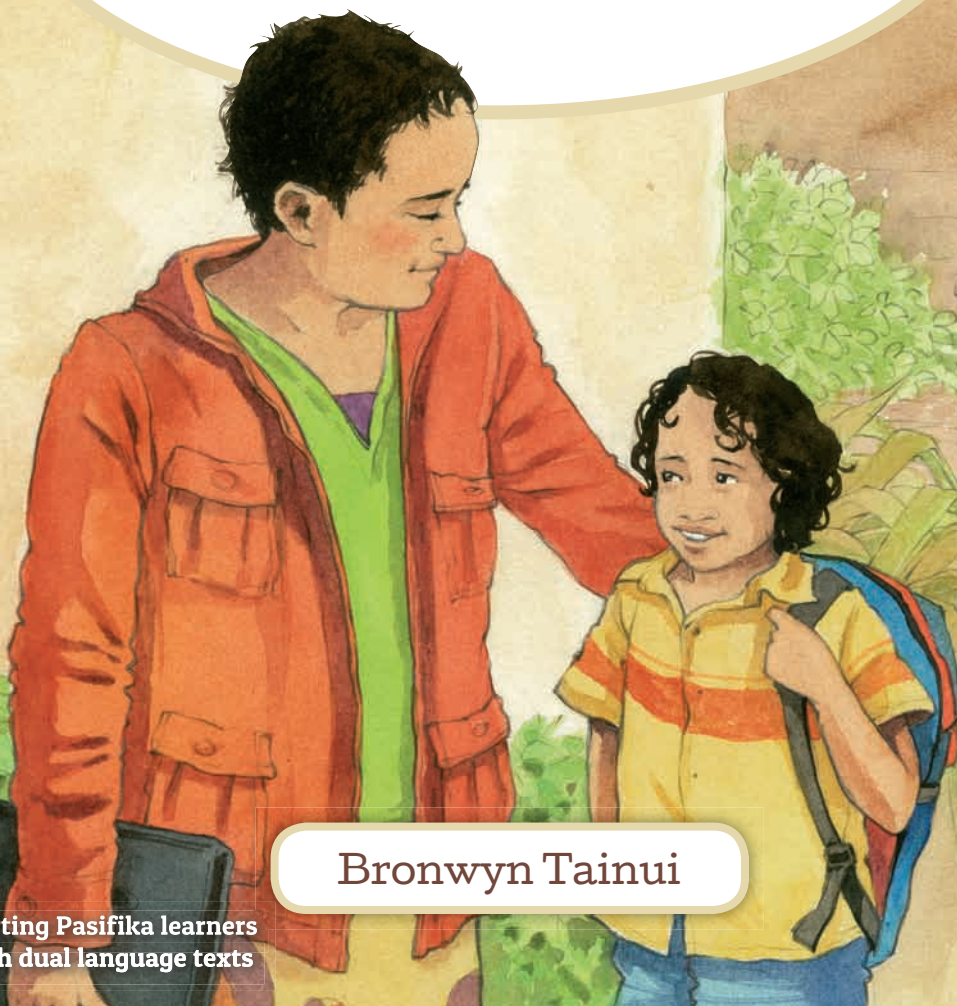

'Ī reira, kua rauka mai te manako!



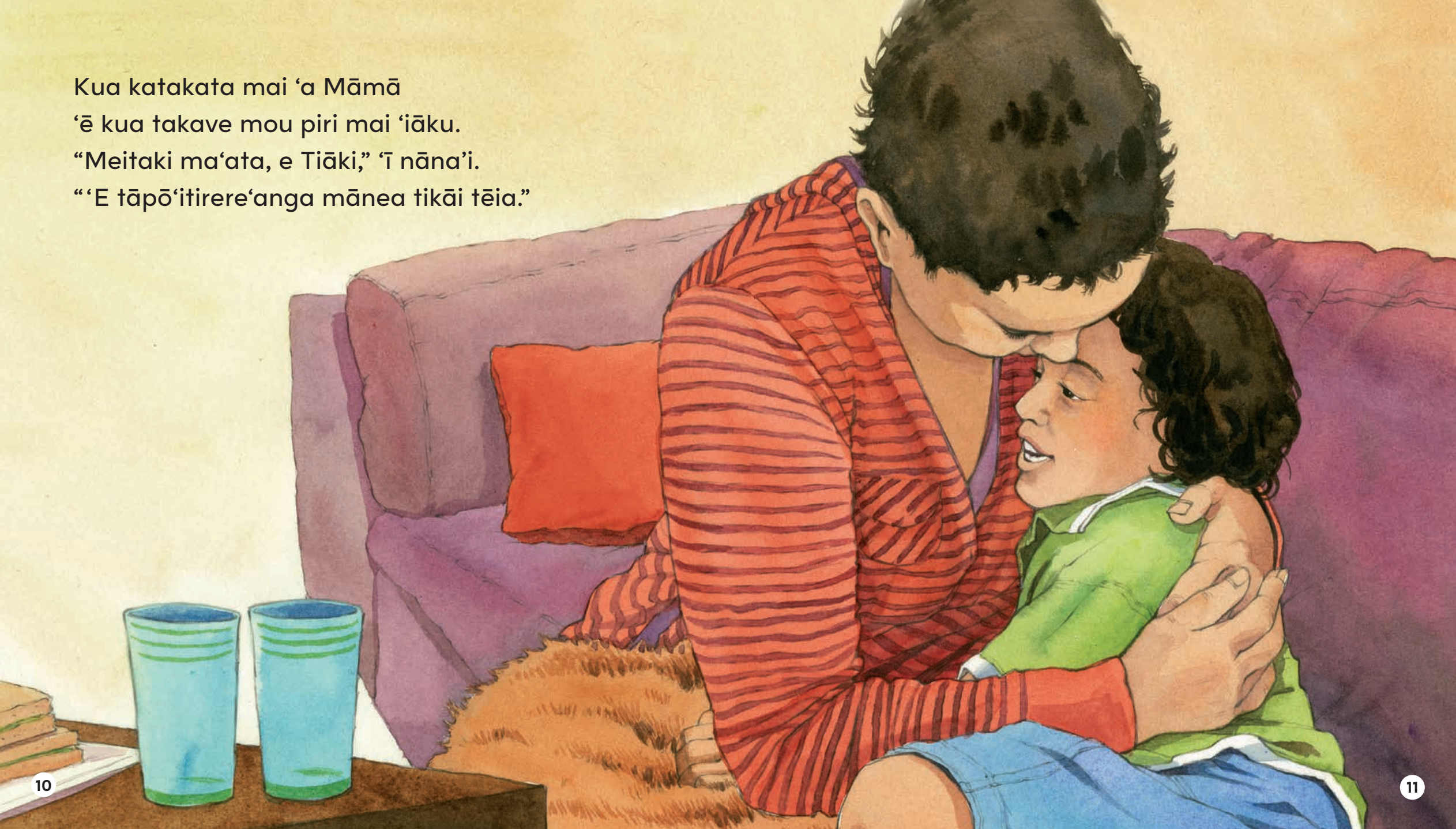
'I te Ma'anākai, kua tāmā 'a Māmā 'i te 'are.

“‘E tāpō'itirere'anga mānea tikāi tēia.”





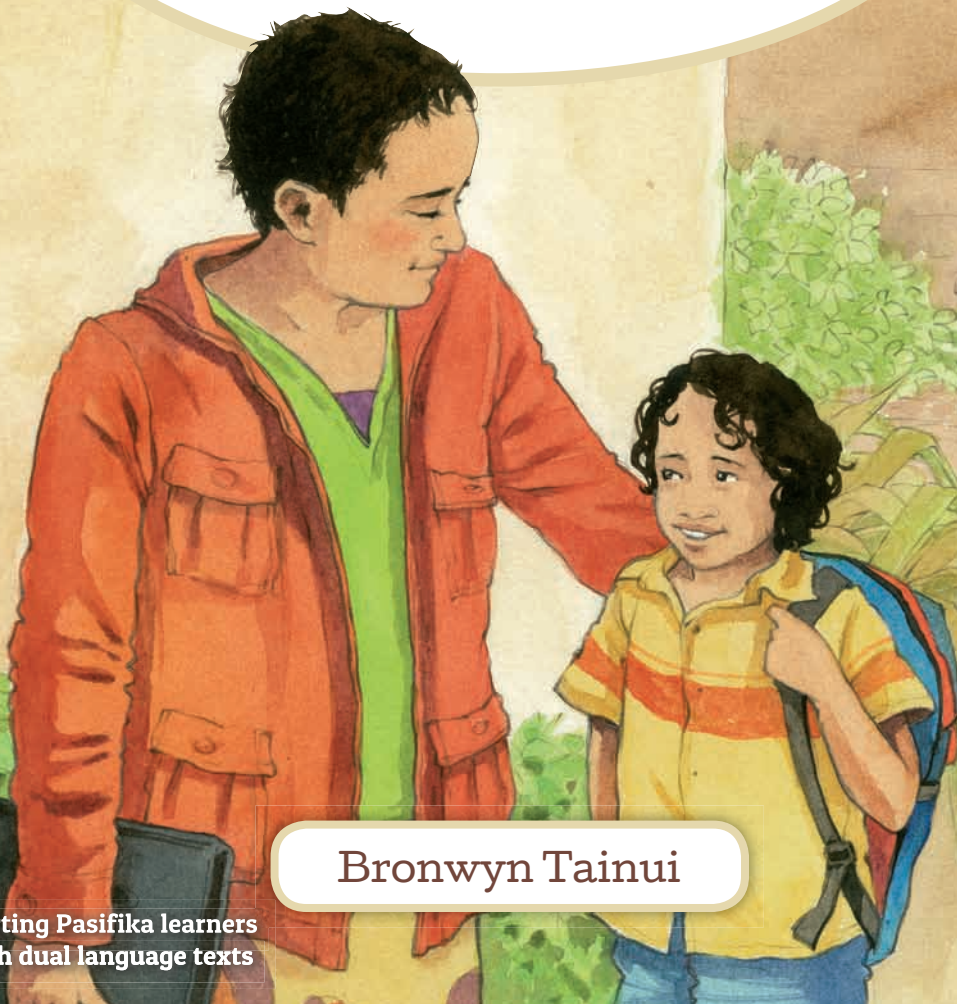

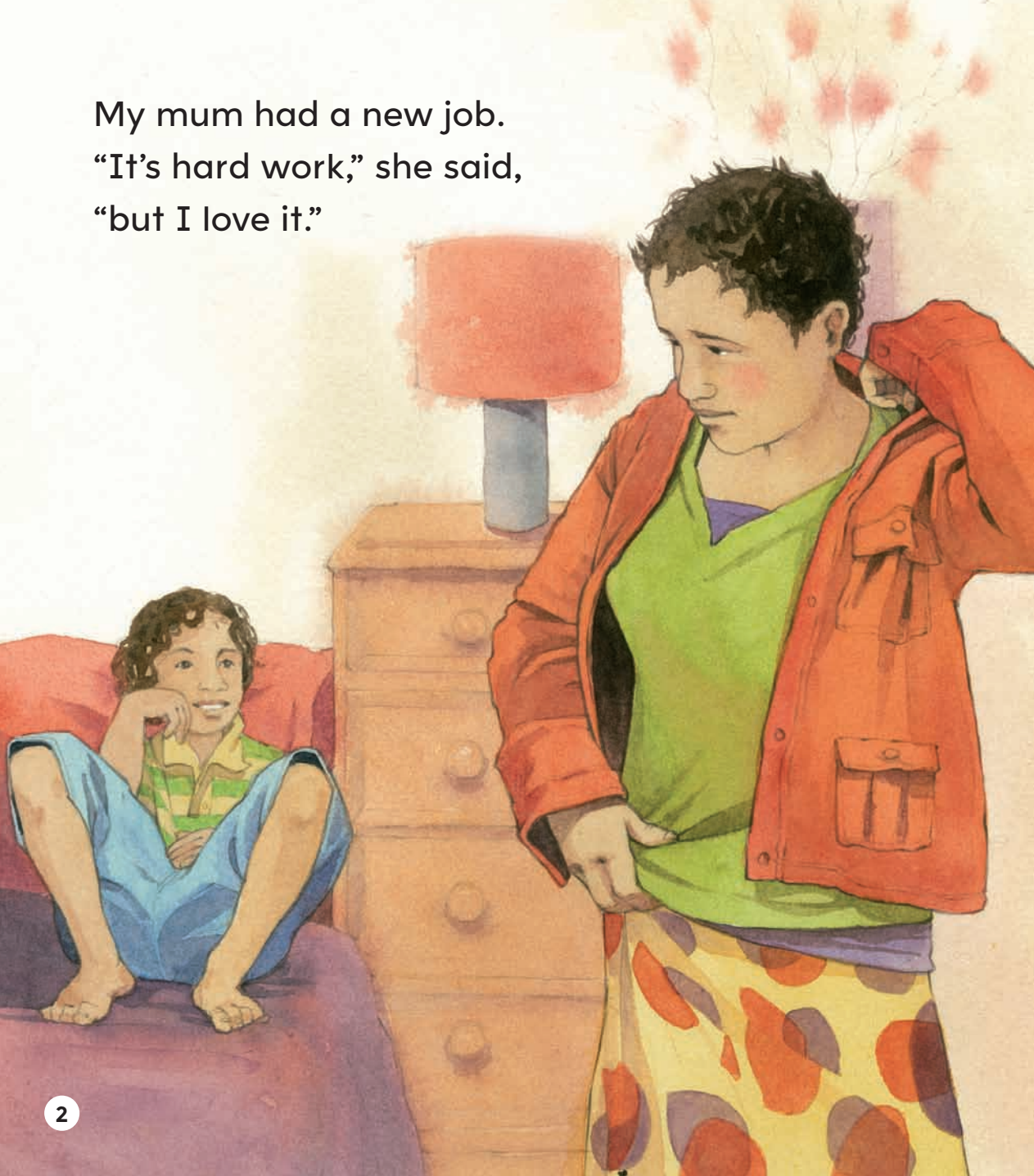
Mum's New Job
