


Nāunau ki he Akó

he pongipongi Tokonakí.





Na'á na 'ilo ai 'a e 'ū nge'esi fīngota

'a ē 'oku sai'ia taha ai 'a Laá.


Na'e pehē ange leva 'ene fa'eé,

kia ‘Anitī Lise ‘i hono fai ‘ahó.


‘I he tuku ‘a e lotú he ‘aho Sāpaté,







Aunty Lise has lots of kahoā

didn't have one of those!




After the Saturday morning shopping,

at Titahi Bay.




They found some yellow and white shells.
