

# Rules

## The numbers game

Place the board on the table and put the yellow, green and orange cards in piles face down beside it.

Throw six to start. Take turns clockwise.

If you land on a plain white square stay there.

If you land on a square with an instruction, do what it says.


If you land on a yellow square, the next person picks up a yellow card. Yellow cards have questions about general time (the seasons, the effects of the sun and the moon on time, festivals). The person will read the top question or statement from the yellow pack. If you get it correct they will tell you. Then you can move forward one more square. If you get it wrong stay where you are.

If you land on a green square the next person picks up a green card. Green cards have questions about clock time. The person will read the top question or statement from the green pack. If you get it correct you move forward one more square. If you get it wrong stay where you are.

If you land on an orange square the next person picks up an orange card. (Orange cards have questions about calendar time). That person will read the top question or statement from the orange pack. If you get it correct you move forward one more square. If you get it wrong stay where you are.

The winner is the first person to get home.

Some questions are hard. Some are very easy. There are more easy questions than hard!
